

**NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF FINAL PUBLIC ENVIRONMENT REPORT (PER)**  
*Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act) – Section 99(4)*

**FAIRHILL COAL PROJECT**  
*EPBC 2019/8549*

Futura Resources Limited, through its wholly owned subsidiary, Fairhill Coking Coal Pty Ltd, is proposing to develop the Fairhill Coal Project. The Fairhill Coal Project is located within the Bowen Basin and lies approximately 55 km northeast of Emerald and 195 km west of Rockhampton, in Central Queensland. The project involves the development, operation and rehabilitation of a small scale open cut mine, producing up to 1.7 million tons per annum (Mtpa) run of mine (ROM) metallurgical coal. Associated infrastructure including temporary offices, workshops and access roads will also be constructed as part of the project.

The proposed action has been determined a controlled action under the EPBC Act. The controlling provisions are '*Listed threatened species and communities (sections 18 & 18A), and a water resource, in relation to coal seam gas development and large coal mining developments (sections 24D & 24E)*'.

In accordance with section 98(1)(c) of the EPBC Act, the draft PER was made available for public comment from 23 February 2021 – 23 March 2021. No public submissions were received during this period. The PER has been finalised for assessment by the Commonwealth Department of Agriculture, Water and the Environment.
